REVERSING WARNING



Reversing warning unit

The reversing warning unit (also called back-up alarm) gives a warning to road users behind a reversing truck, thus contributing to increased safety.

The reversing warning unit is integrated in the tail lamp of the truck. The unit automatically emits a warning signal when a reverse gear is selected. Approximately 100 high-intensity signals per minute are emitted, at maximum 73 dB(A) (7.5 metres).

The BUPALARM variant comes with a switch in order to turn off the reversing warning sound. The BUPAL12 variant does not have a switch, which means the warning will always sound when reversing.

BUPALARM Reversing warning, with switch to enable/disable

BUPAL12 Reversing warning, without switch to enable/disable

SAFETY
